**ONLINE APPLICATION**

Complete and submit the online application including the following uploaded materials:

**One-page Professional Resume**

**Short Answer Prompts** (4-6 Sentences each):

1. Describe your career and education goals and how this fellowship would help you achieve them.
2. What is the purpose of the U.S. Constitution and how do you believe it ought to be interpreted?
3. What is your understanding of originalism?
4. If you were appointed to the U.S. Supreme Court and had the power to overturn any previous decision of the Court, which would it be and why?
5. If you were advising policy-makers in Washington on ways to improve the legal system, what would be your top suggestion?

**Legal Writing Sample** (5-10 pages): Examples include case brief or memorandum, journal article or moot court brief.

**SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS**

The following materials must be submitted in addition to the online application:

**Official Law School Transcript:** Must be mailed in sealed envelope or faxed/emailed directly from the home university the contact information below.

**Letter of Recommendation:** One letter from a former employer. Any additional letters may be from a professor, dean or advisor. Letters must be sent through the online application system or sent via fax or mail using the contact information below.
