HONORING EXCELLENCE IN JOURNALISM

For 30 years, TFAS has fostered the careers of outstanding journalists, including Pulitzer Prize-winning reporters, editors of national magazines and authors of bestselling books. Your support of the 30th Annual TFAS Journalism Awards Dinner will enable us to develop the next generation of excellent journalists while honoring today's leaders who are paving the way.

TFAS is pleased to present **Benjamin Hall** with the **Kenneth Y. Tomlinson Award for Courageous Journalism**. Hall currently serves as a correspondent for Fox News Channel (FNC). In March of 2022, while covering the war in Ukraine, Hall was catastrophically wounded when his team was struck by incoming fire outside Kyiv. Hall is the author of the book "SAVED: A War Reporter's Mission to Make It Home," which details the story of his survival, his dramatic rescue along with his arduous and ongoing recovery.

Brian C. Anderson, editor of City Journal, the cultural and political quarterly published by the Manhattan Institute, will be presented with the **Thomas L. Phillips Career Achievement Award** for his remarkable career. Formerly, he was senior editor of City Journal and a research associate at the American Enterprise Institute. As editor, Anderson has overseen the enormously successful expansion of City Journal's website, which now reaches millions of readers. In his years editing City Journal, the magazine has continued to be one of the nation's premier public-policy magazines.

The evening will also honor the life and legacy of **Joseph Rago**, a Pulitzer Prize-winning editorial writer for The Wall Street Journal, who died in 2017 at the age of 34. In memory of Joe, TFAS and the Rago family established the **Joseph Rago Memorial Fellowship for Excellence in Journalism**, providing a nine-month internship with The Wall Street Journal's editorial team. **Sierra McClain** will accept the 2023 Rago Fellowship at the dinner.

Finally, TFAS will present our 2023 **Robert Novak Journalism Fellowship Awards** to the next generation of top writers. These Fellowships give promising journalists the resources to undertake career-building and impactful projects. Named in honor of columnist Robert D. Novak, the program has funded more than 150 journalists since its founding.

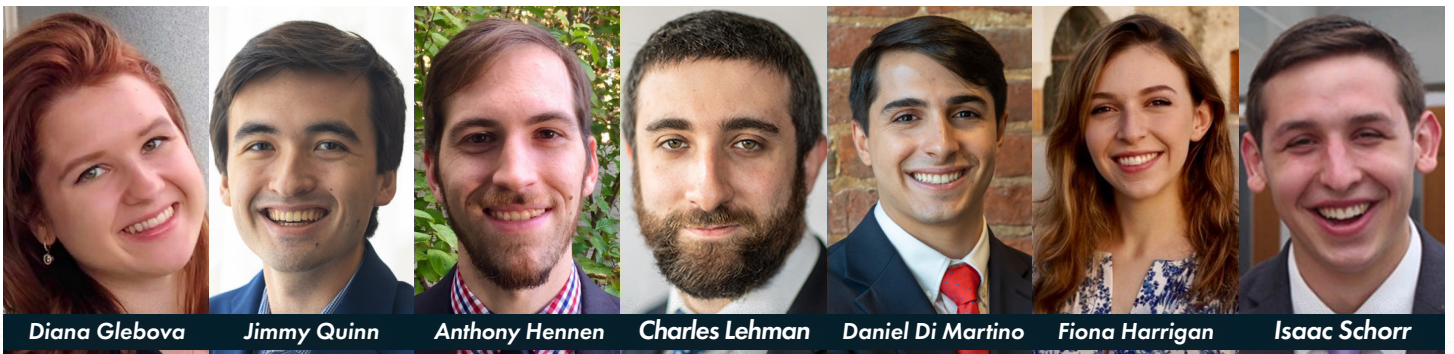
