- If you were appointed to the U.S. Supreme Court and had the power to overturn any previous decision of the Court, which would it be and why?
- If you were advising policymakers in Washington on ways to improve the legal system, what would be your top suggestion?
- Which of the following economic systems is best suited to promote economic prosperity – Mixed Economy (regulated market economy and welfare state), Socialism, Free Market Capitalism, or Other? Please explain.

**Legal Writing Sample (5-10 pages):**

- Examples include case briefs or memorandum, journal articles or moot court briefs
