TFAS is pleased to present James Bennet with the Kenneth Y. Tomlinson Award for Courageous Journalism. James Bennet is a senior editor and the weekly Lexington columnist at The Economist. He was previously the editorial page editor of the New York Times, where he oversaw the digital transformation of the paper's opinion department and led it to two Pulitzer Prizes in four years, its first in more than a decade. Before joining the Times, Bennet was the editor in chief and co-president of The Atlantic.

Lance Morrow, contributing columnist at The Wall Street Journal and former TIME magazine editor and essayist will be presented with the **Thomas L. Phillips Career Achievement Award** for his outstanding career. Morrow's award-winning essays, appearing in TIME, Smithsonian, The New York Times, The Atlantic, and other publications, have offered probing analyses of American culture and politics in the transition from the 20th to the 21st century.

To honor the life and legacy of **Joseph Rago**, a Pulitzer Prize-winning editorial writer for The Wall Street Journal who died in 2017 at the age of 34, TFAS and the Rago family established the **Joseph Rago Memorial Fellowships for Excellence in Journalism**, providing a nine-month internship with The Wall Street Journal's editorial team. **Jillian Lederman** and **Luke Lyman** will accept the 2024 Rago Fellowships at the dinner.

Finally, TFAS will present our 2024 **Robert Novak Journalism Fellowships** to the next generation of writers. These Fellowships give promising journalists the resources to undertake career-building and impactful projects. Named in honor of columnist **Robert D. Novak**, the program has funded more than 150 journalists since its founding.
